

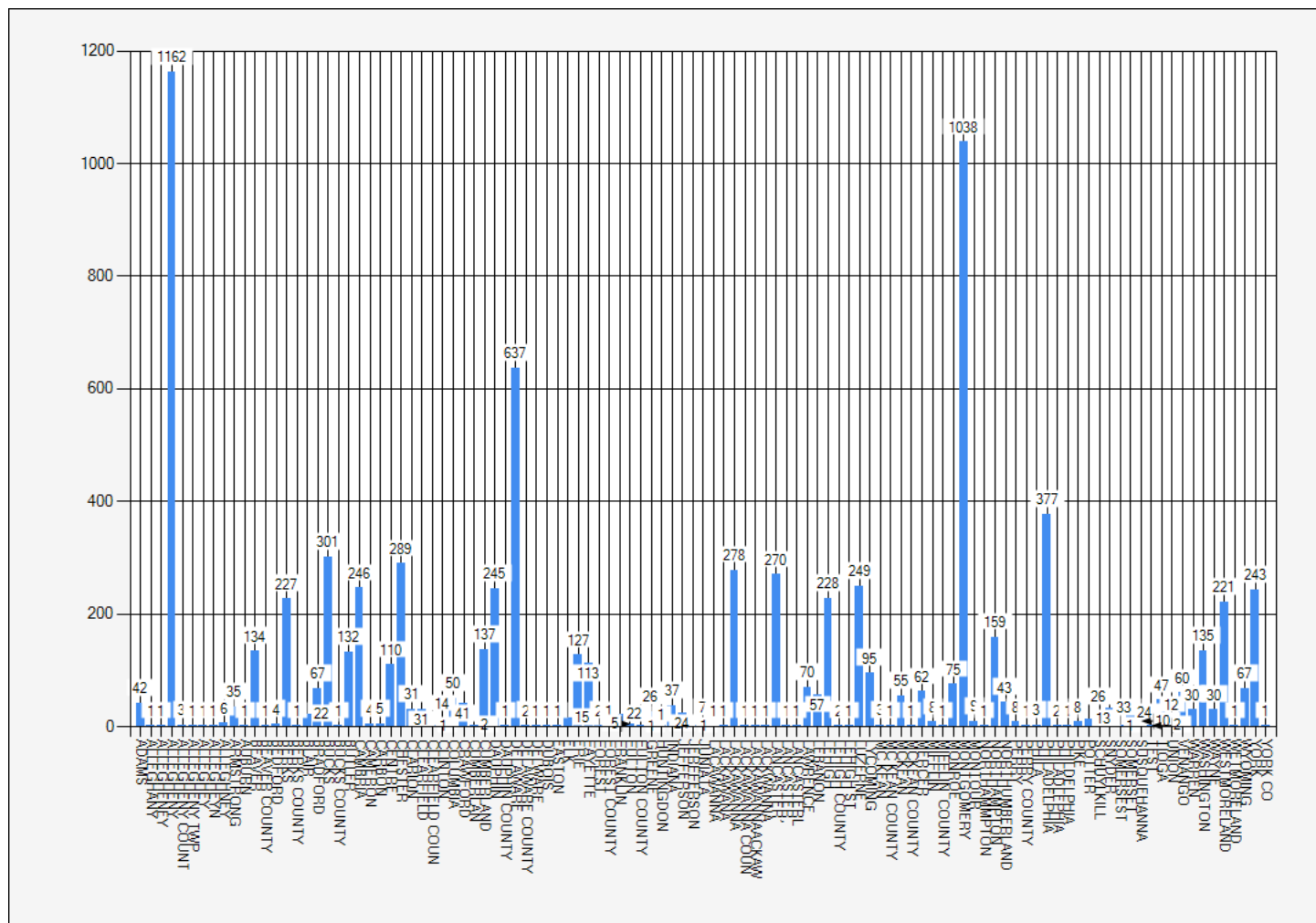
Summary

During **2019** there were a total of **8,444** reports sent to the PUC from PA One Call via the data exchange service.

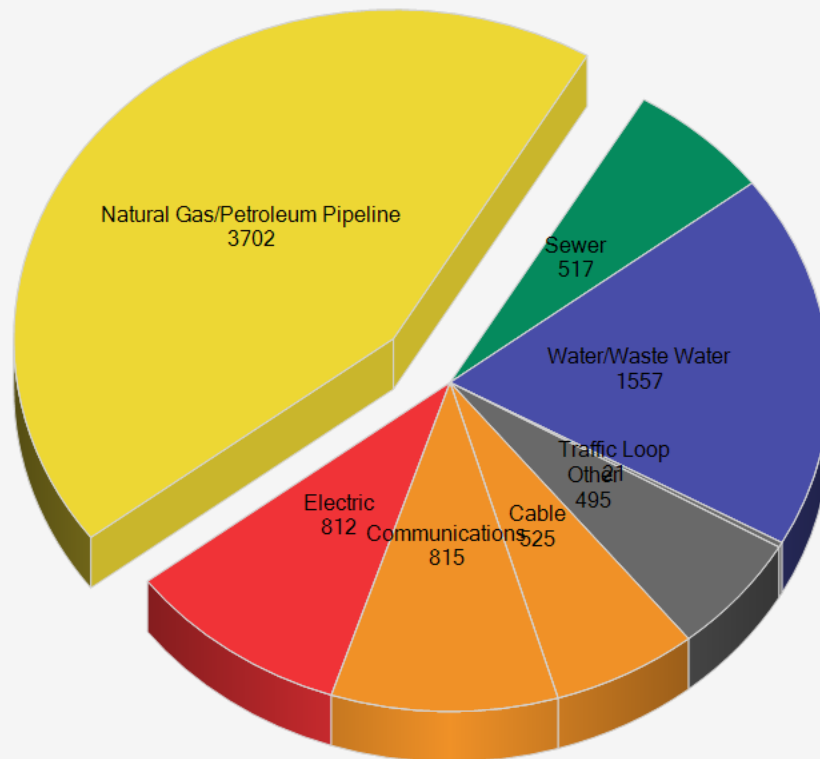
There were **827** investigations opened and **379** investigations closed. A total of **1,154** violations were found and **\$720,150.00** of penalties were administered.

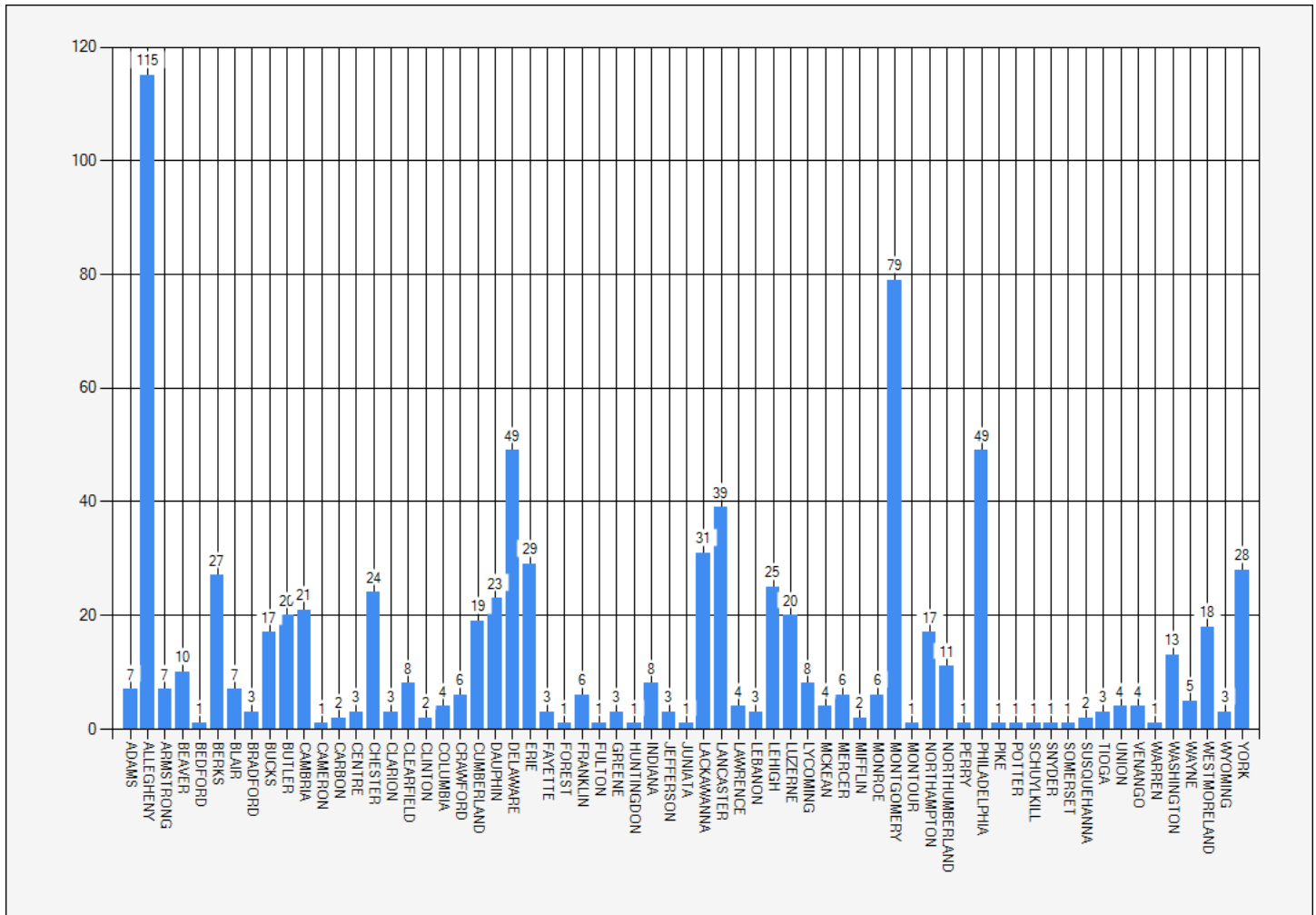
Reports Sent by County



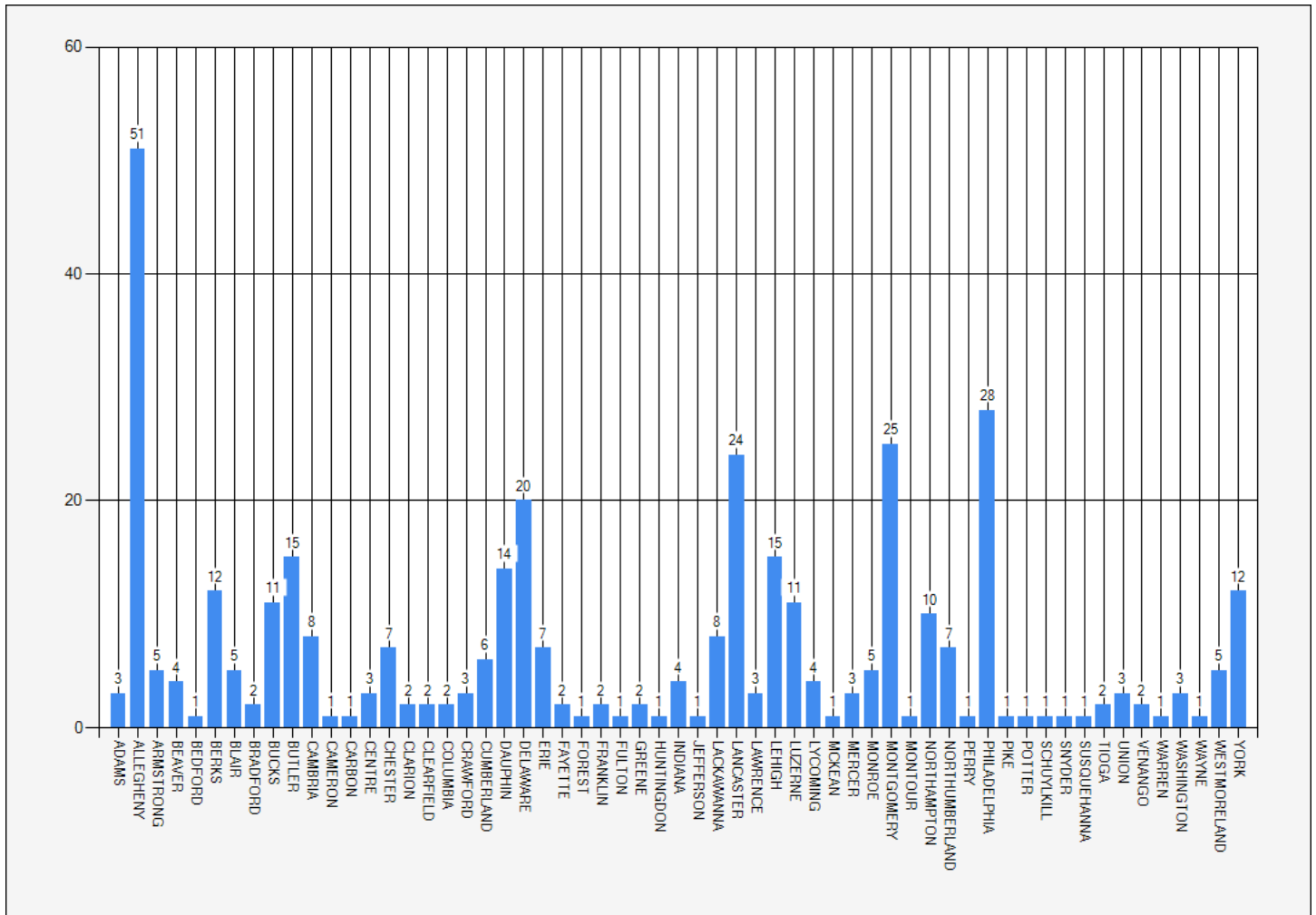
Reports Sent by Affected Operation



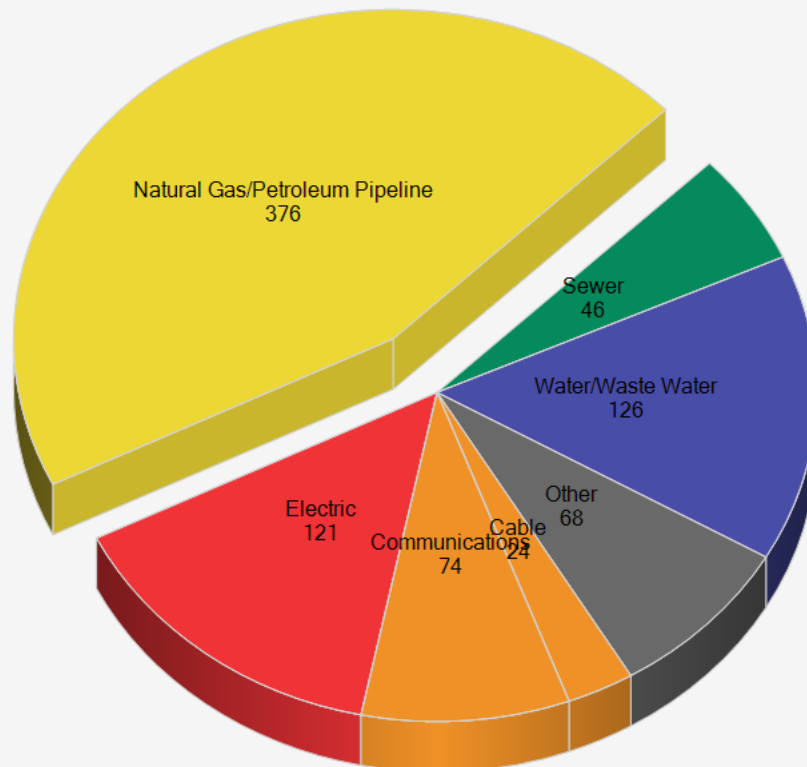
Investigations Opened by County



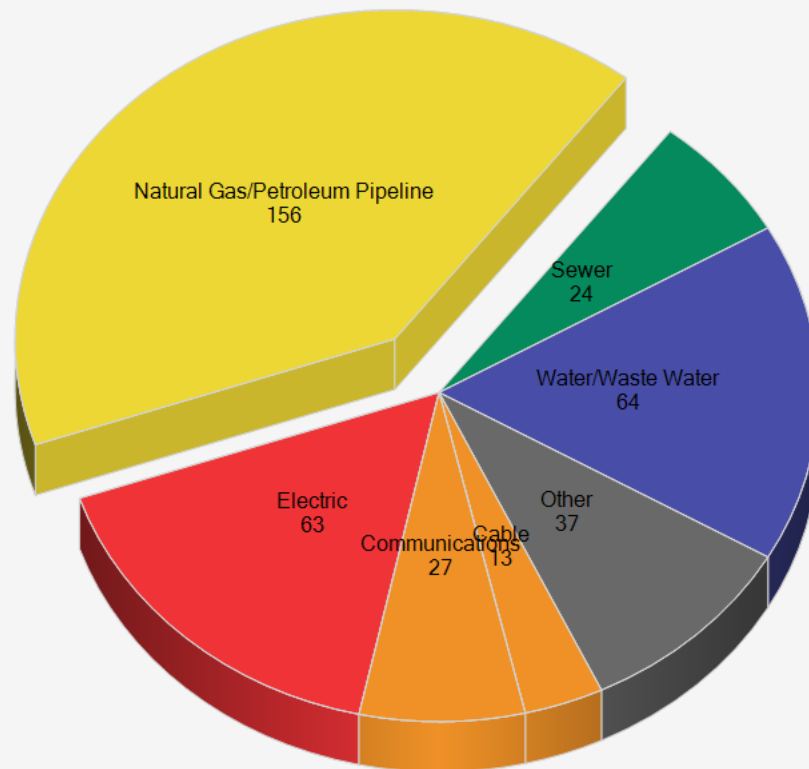
Investigations Closed by County



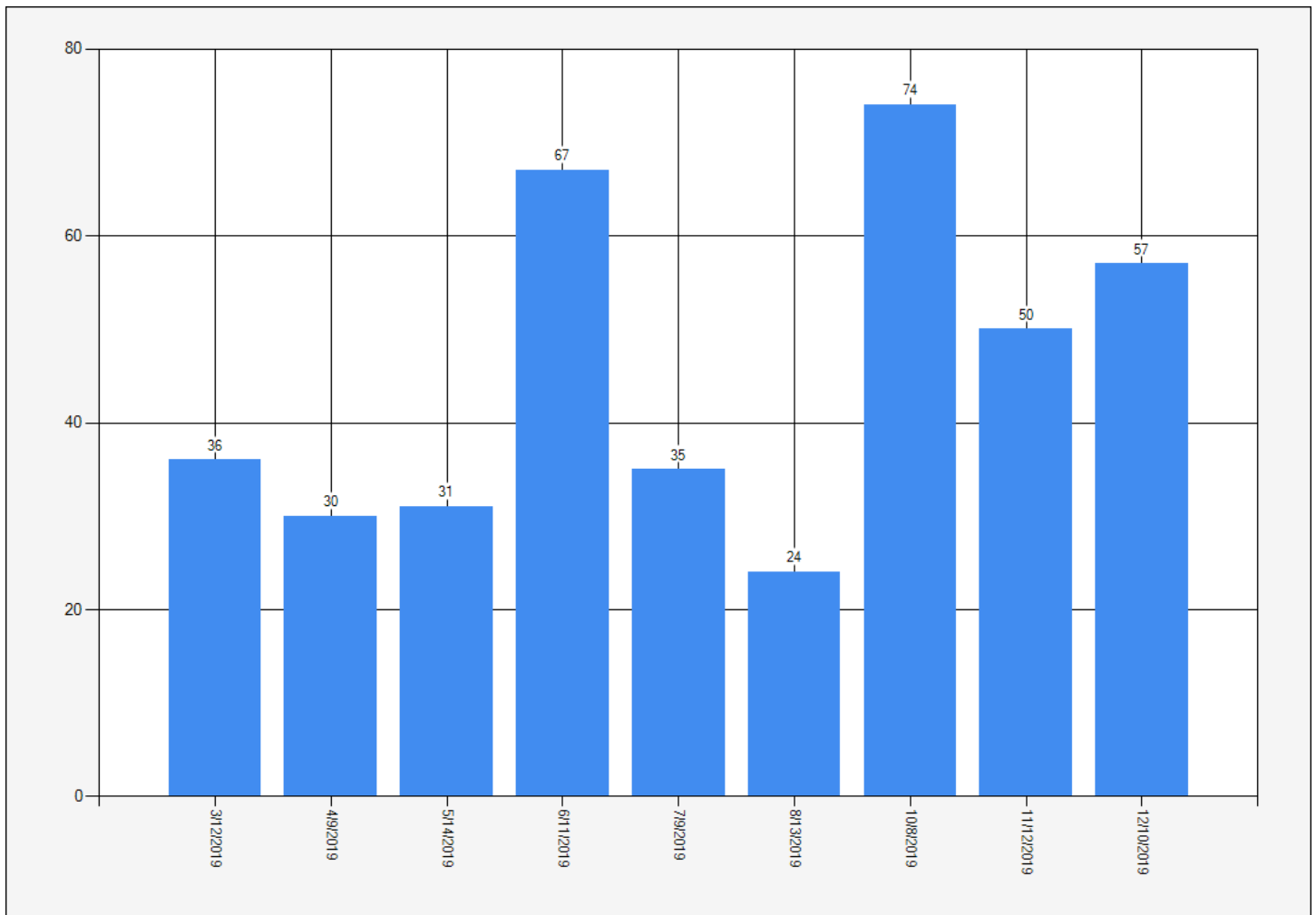
Investigations Opened by Affected Operation



Investigations Closed by Affected Operation

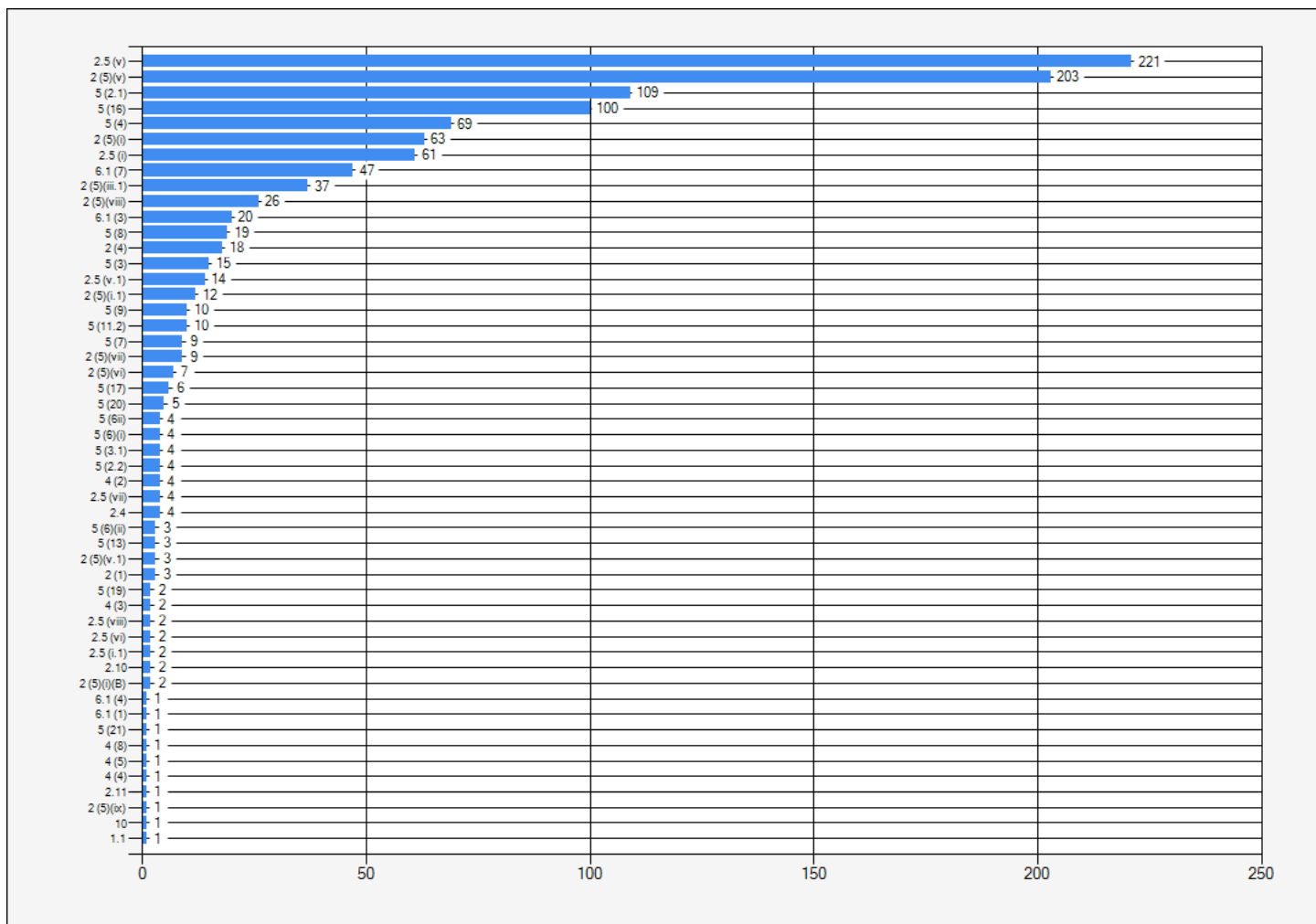


Investigations Heard by Month
